Neighborhood Safety Alert

As many of you have observed, speeding and rolling through stop signs have become real concerns in our neighborhood. For example, in August, a substitute school bus driver blew through a stop sign—putting kids and neighbors at risk.

Let's all do our part: slow down and come to a full stop at every sign. Small actions from each of us make a big impact on keeping ESL safe.

Looking ahead, East Spring Lake will be part of a county speed study this Spring. The county shared the following update:

"Long Lake Drive, Spring Rock Terrace, and Sandpoint Drive will all qualify to be studied. Our data collection season takes place between January and May of every school year, so that is when we would be able to complete our speed study."

This study may eventually result in speed bumps being installed, depending on the findings.
