

Dear Neighbors,

Beginning Thursday, May 7, 2026 the East Spring Lake HOA Board will distribute two (2) new key fobs to recreational member households. These fobs will replace the prior physical key method.

### **Eligibility & Security**

All fobs will be delivered in an **inactive status**. Fobs may be activated for households in **good standing**, meaning all HOA dues are fully paid and there are no open covenant violations.

### **Activation Steps:**

1. **Complete the Fob Acknowledgement Form:** Confirm receipt of your two fobs by scanning the QR code below, going to [this link](#), or, if you prefer, print the attached acknowledgement form, sign and then return to Ally Bernstein, ESL HOA VP at 2697 Long Lake Terrace. Your fobs will be activated within 24–48 hours of receipt of your completed acknowledgement.
2. **Verify SAYOR Status:** If you have **Swim At Your Own Risk (SAYOR)** privileges, your fobs will be marked with an orange “S” sticker. If you have SAYOR and do not see the indicator for SAYOR, please email the pool chair at [eslpoolhoa@gmail.com](mailto:eslpoolhoa@gmail.com) to confirm your status. If you have a yellow form accompanying your letter, you are required to submit an updated waiver of liability to the HOA because we are unable to locate one for your household.



**Swim at Your Own Risk (Sayor):** The ESL SAYOR program allows access to the pool during non-lifeguard hours. If you do not currently have SAYOR access but would like to add it, please review the **"SAYOR Guidelines & Release"** by clicking the **"Residents"** tab at [EastSpringLake.com](http://EastSpringLake.com) and opening the **"Residents Documents"**. You must submit the physical signed release and a **\$50.00 refundable deposit** to the Pool Chair to gain access to the pool during non-lifeguard hours.

In the event that a fob is lost or damaged, a new fob can be provided for a \$25 replacement.
